

Hong Tai Electric Industrial CO., Ltd Honored in the “Taiwan Best-in-Class Companies” Category of the 2026 Taiwan FINI 100

At the annual Taiwan FINI 100 awards ceremony held by the Taiwan Institute of Directors (TWIoD) on September 2, 2026, Hong Tai Electric Industrial Co., Ltd. (TWSE: 1612) was recognized in the “Taiwan Best-in-Class Companies” category, reflecting the company’s strong performance in market standing, profit growth, and governance resilience.

The Taiwan FINI 100 is jointly organized by TWIoD and the Corporate Development Research Center (CDRC), and is one of the few authoritative corporate rankings in Taiwan compiled from the perspective of foreign institutional investors. The “Taiwan Best-in-Class Companies” category targets companies with a market capitalization between US\$100 million and US\$500 million that show strong growth momentum. Selection criteria cover market liquidity as well as three-year revenue and profit growth, while companies ranking in the bottom 20% of corporate governance assessments or with material deficiencies are excluded, ensuring the category highlights the most promising mid-sized enterprises.

Founded in 1968, Hong Tai has upheld its guiding philosophy of “integrity, diligence, and continuous innovation” throughout more than half a century in the wire and cable industry. Its product range spans from bare copper wire to 161kV power cables and a wide array of other applications, and the company holds numerous certifications, including ISO 9001, IECQ QC080000, and ISO 50001, among others. In August of this year, the company also received the Manufacturing Quality Excellence Award at the 28th National Quality Award. This latest recognition in the Taiwan FINI 100 further affirms the solid results the company has achieved in recent years in business growth and corporate governance.
